

## Fact sheet of culture of Epidendrum

Epidendrum are mainly represented by about 1000 species in Central and South America. They come in two forms those with oval pseudobulbs, and those with reed-shaped stems, in both cases, the floral stem develops at the top. Most species enjoy medium conditions

### **LIGHT :**

20,000 to 40,000 Lux is direct exposure to the sun, but avoid summer exposure without gradual habituation.

### **TEMPERATURE :**

15 to 25°C depending on whether the plant is cold or temperate wintering cooler around 15-16°C.

### **WATERING :**

constant humidity is recommended except in winter or rest can be observed especially for cold plants.

### **HUMIDITY :**

70 to 80%.

**FERTILIZER :**

every week during a growing season, reduce strongly or even stop in winter

**SUBSTRATE :**

Adapts to all types of substrate the best results being obtained with a bark base.
